

Augustus Saint-Gaudens in New York

A Special Tour Organized for
Members of the Friends of Saint-Gaudens
and Members of the Hood Museum of Art

October 28-29, 2009



The Friends of Saint-Gaudens and the Members of the Hood Museum of Art invite you to join them on a two-day visit to New York City, to explore some of the sites associated with the great American sculptor Augustus Saint-Gaudens (1848-1907).

On Wednesday, October 28th, take a luxury coach from the Upper Valley to New York City, accompanied by your guide Henry Duffy, curator, Saint-Gaudens NHS. On the way, watch the new PBS special documentary *Augustus Saint-Gaudens: Master of American Sculpture* by award-winning filmmaker Paul Sanderson and recently produced by the Saint-Gaudens Memorial.

The **highlight** of our trip will be a tour of *Augustus Saint-Gaudens in the Metropolitan Museum of Art*, with the exhibition curator and Saint-Gaudens scholar, Thayer Tolles, Associate Curator of American Paintings and Sculpture.

We will stay at the historic Roosevelt Hotel (built in 1924) a four-star hotel, on the corner of Madison Avenue and 45th Street. The hotel is in the heart of mid-town Manhattan and is a city landmark where bandleader Guy Lombardo first sang "Auld Lang Syne." The evening is free for you to dine and explore on your own. From the Roosevelt Hotel you are just a few short blocks from Times Square, should you wish to book a Broadway show in advance of the trip.

The next morning we'll take a short walk to The Century Association, designed by architect Stanford White, a close friend of Augustus Saint-Gaudens. There we will be joined for the morning by Samuel White, a great-grandson of the architect, who will introduce us to the collaboration of the two great artists. After a brief tour of the Century, our bus will take us to Madison Park to view the Farragut Monument. From there a short walk takes us to Gramercy Park where we'll see the Player's Club, founded in 1888 by actor Edwin Booth, and one of Saint-Gaudens' favorite places in the city. After lunch on your own, the bus leaves New York for the drive back to the Upper Valley.
